42nd Annual Alaska Resource's Conference Program will focus on Alaska's economy and opportunities

Anchorage, AK – RDC's 42nd Annual Alaska Resources Conference will take place virtually on November 17th. Historically the conference is the largest resource development focused forum in the state, with generally over 800 attendees.

Wednesday's program kicks off with updates from representatives in the fishing, forestry, mining, oil and gas, and tourism industries and features a representative from ANCSA Regional Association, followed by an "Alaska Economic Trends" outlook by State Economist Neal Fried. Additional speakers on Wednesday include presentations from U.S. Senator Lisa Murkowski, U.S. Senator Dan Sullivan, Congressman Don Young, Rex Rock, Sr. with Voice of the Arctic Inupiat. In addition, attendees will hear project updates from Hilcorp Alaska LLC, Kinross Alaska, and ConocoPhillips Alaska. The day's program will end with an Alaska's Rights for Economic Development and AIDEA Project update from Alan Weitzner, Executive Director of AIDEA.
