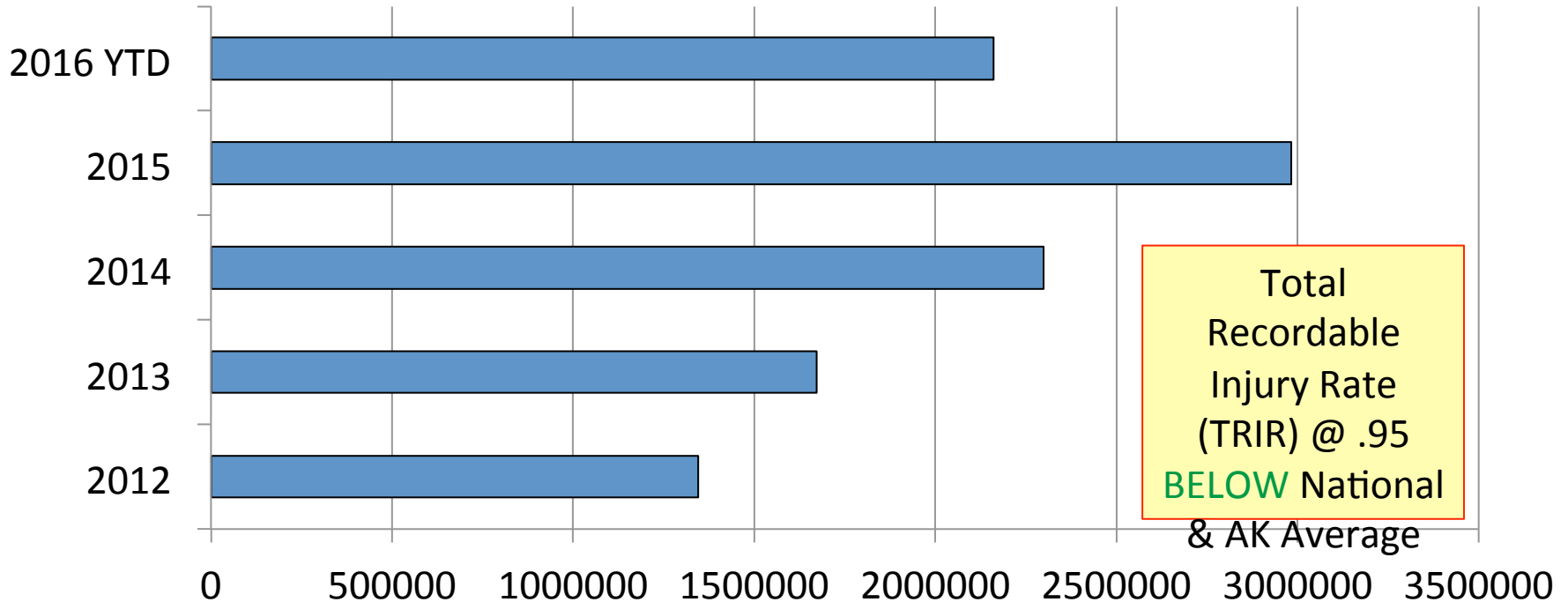

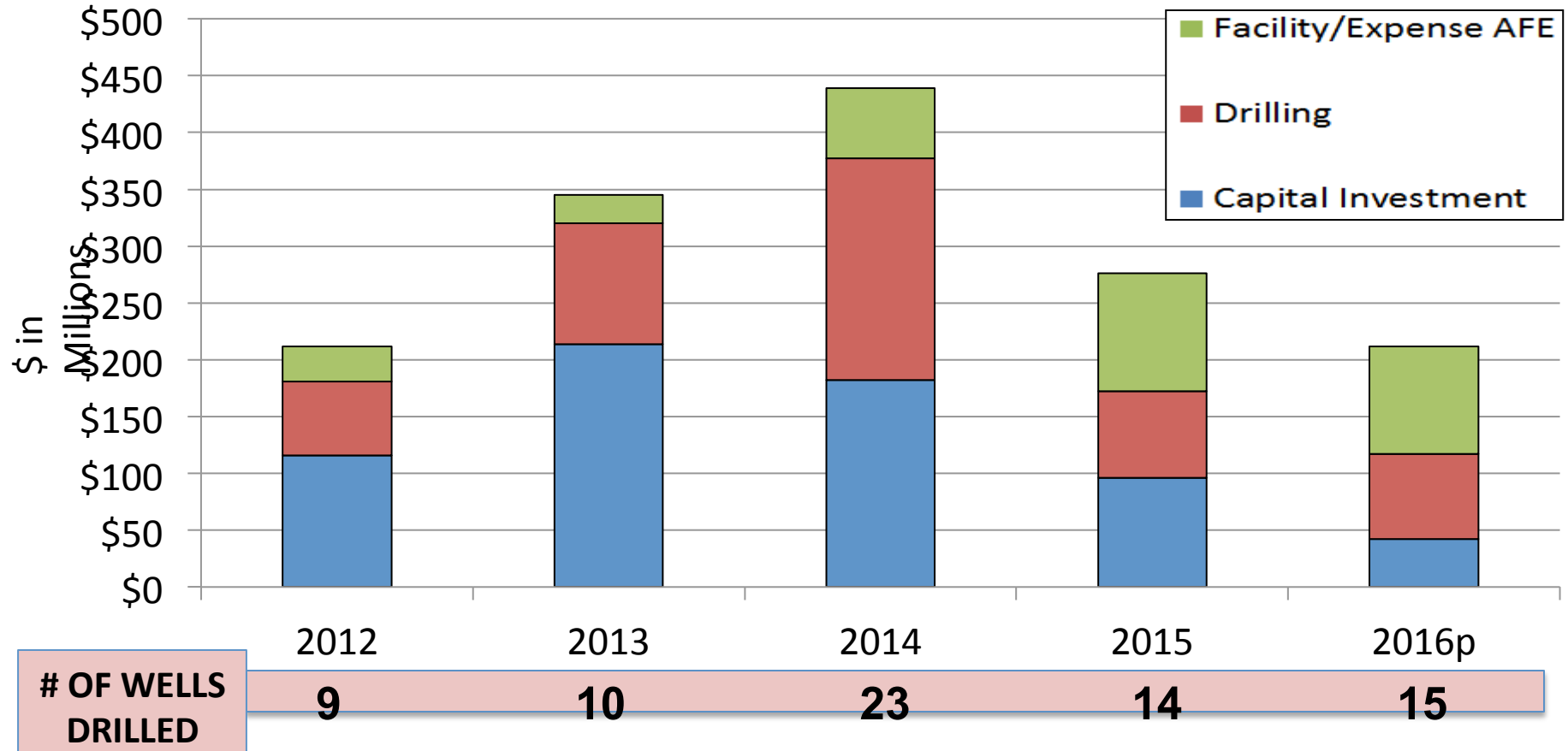

## Total Man Hours





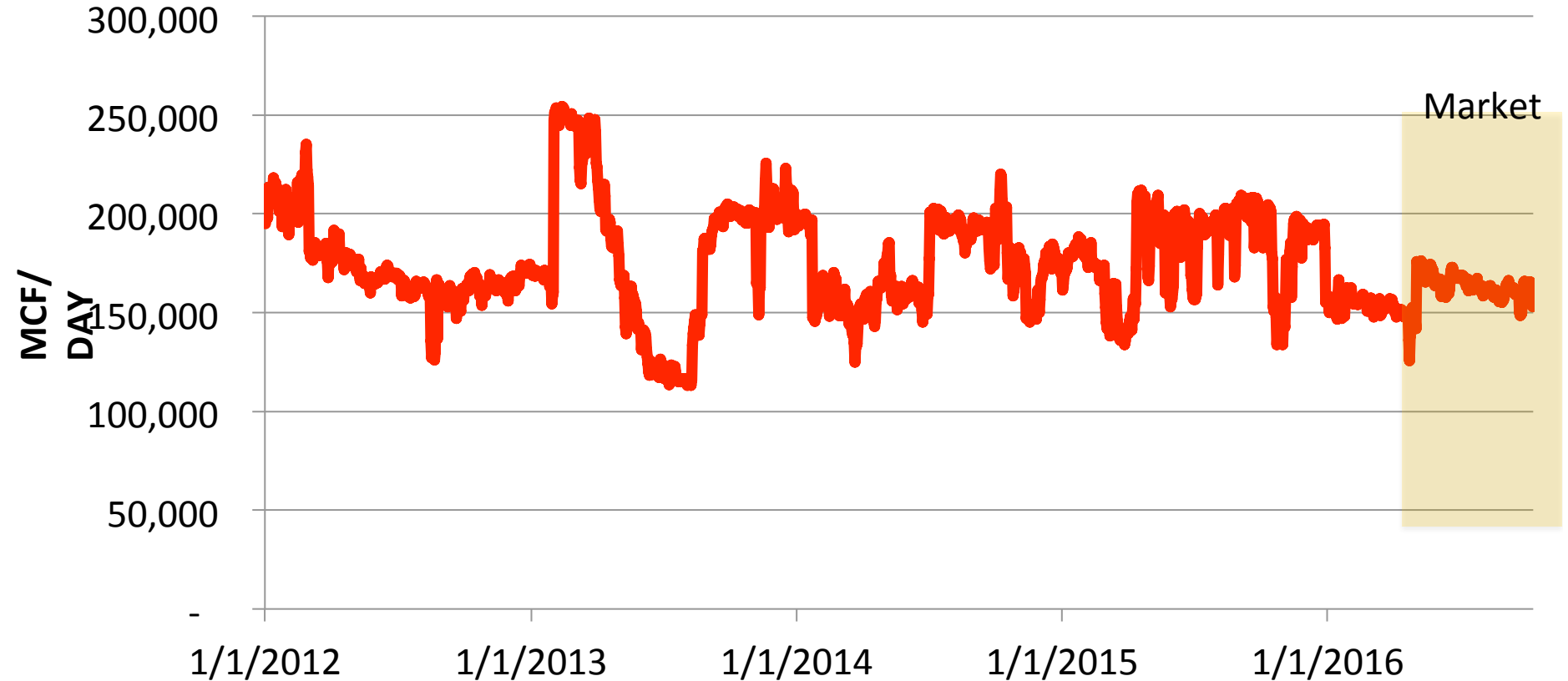

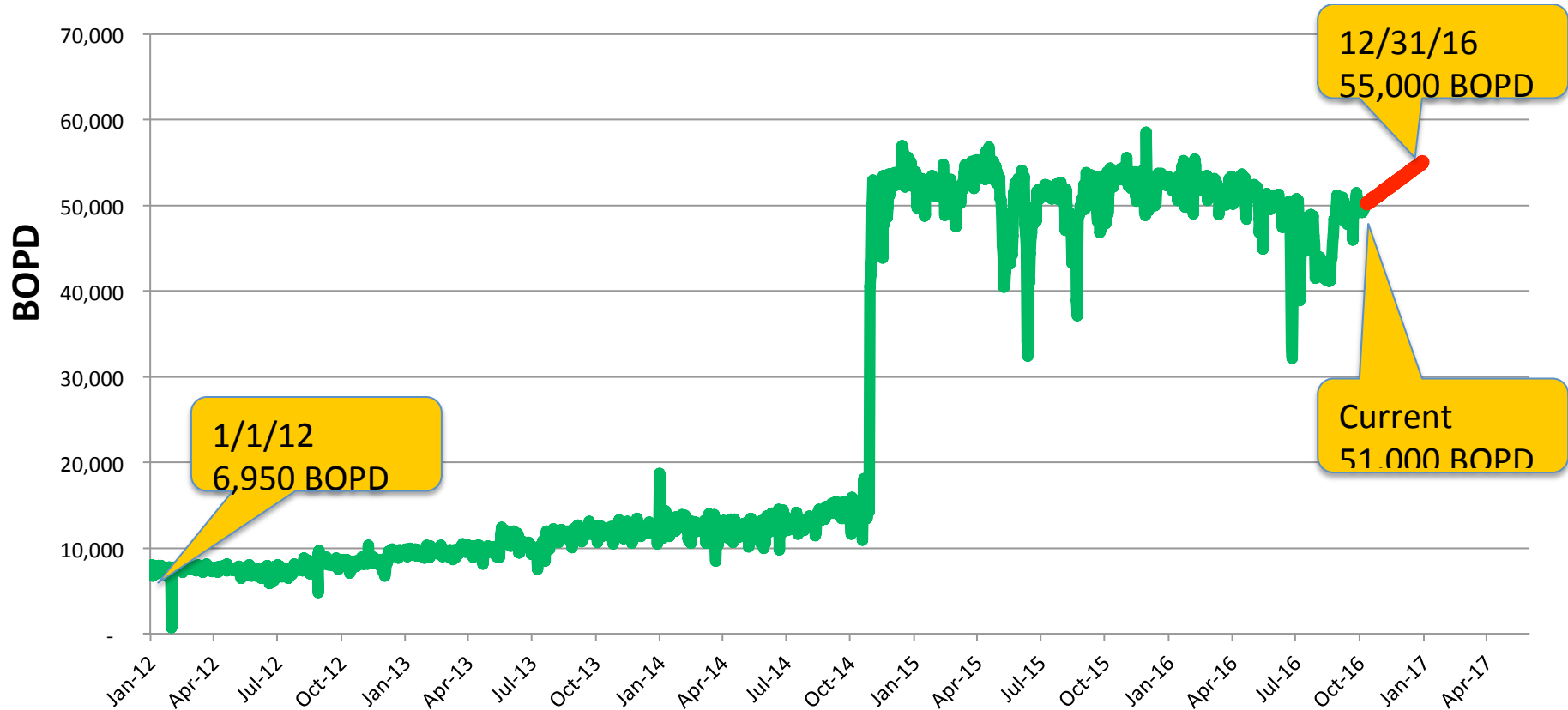

Compressor Upgrade and Optimization at Kenai Gas Field

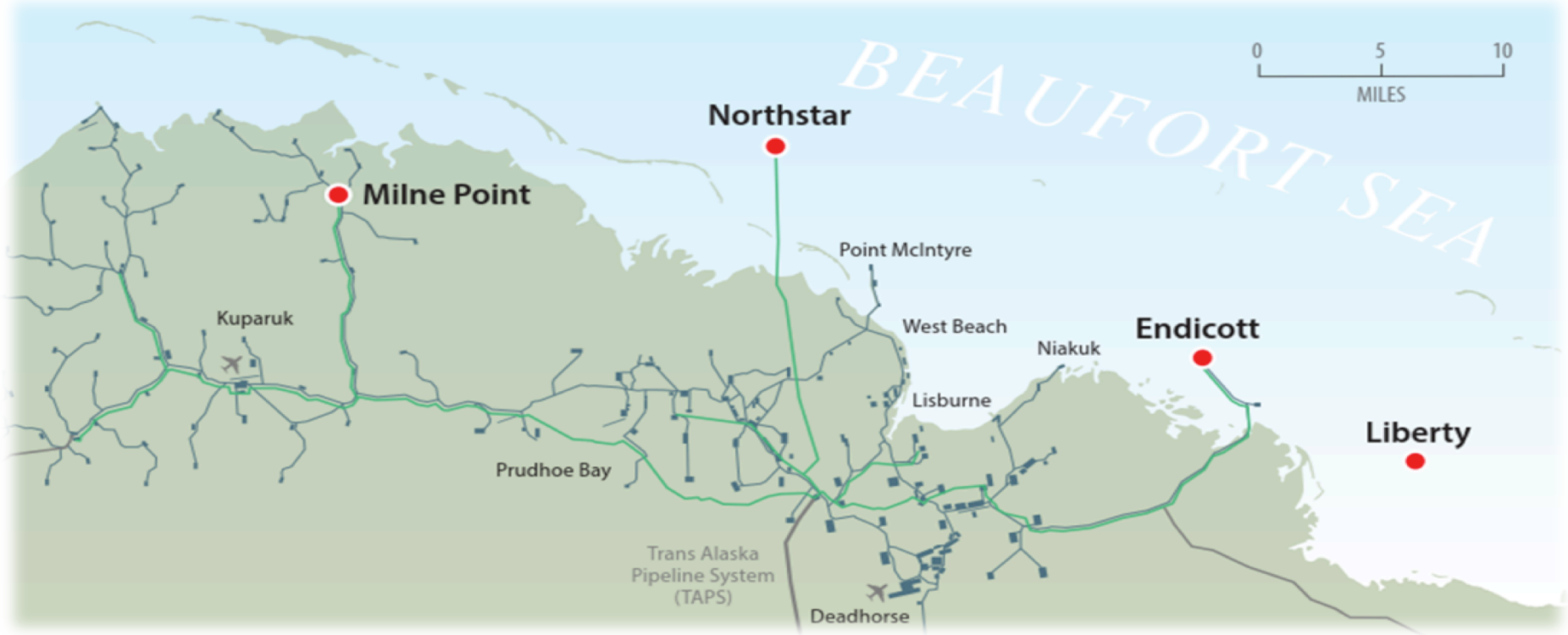
Drilling for Gas on the Kalotsa Pad – Ninilchik (Nov. 2016)

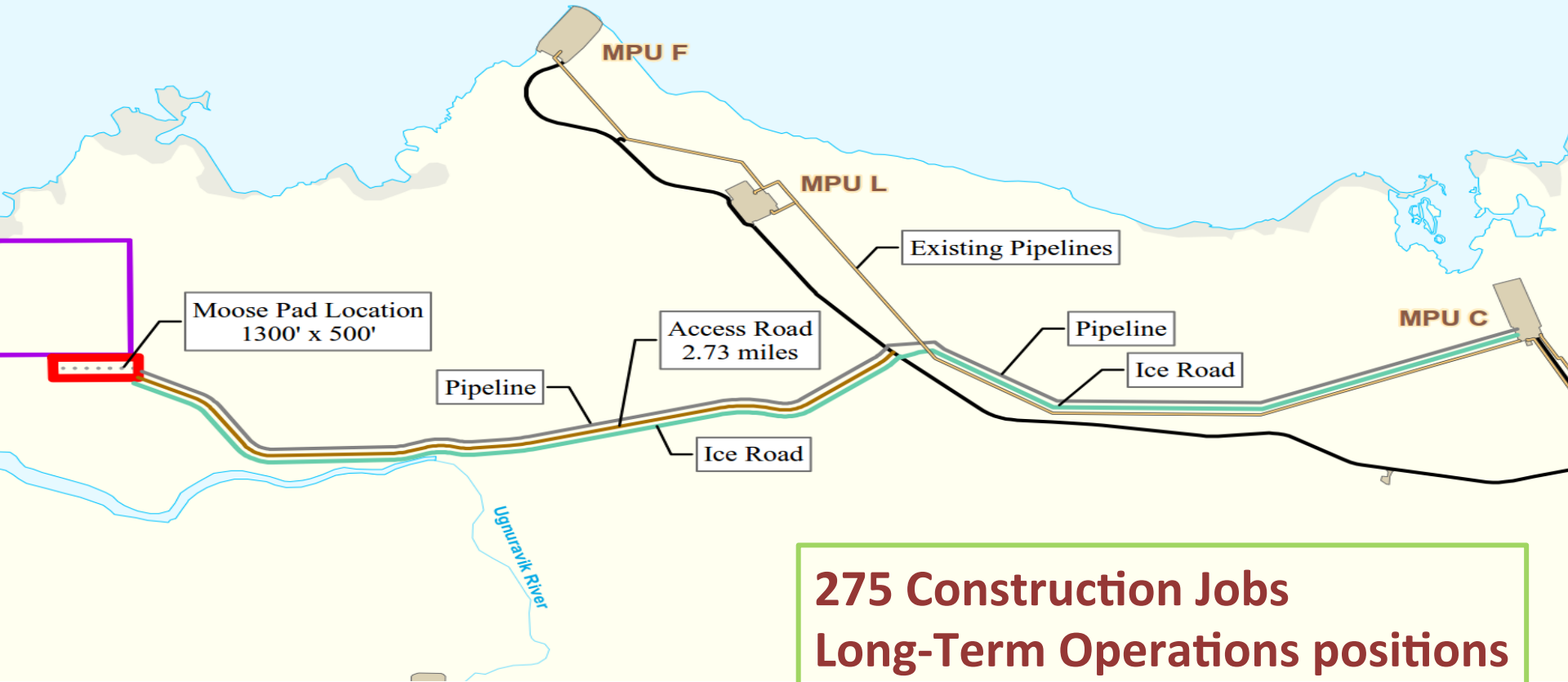

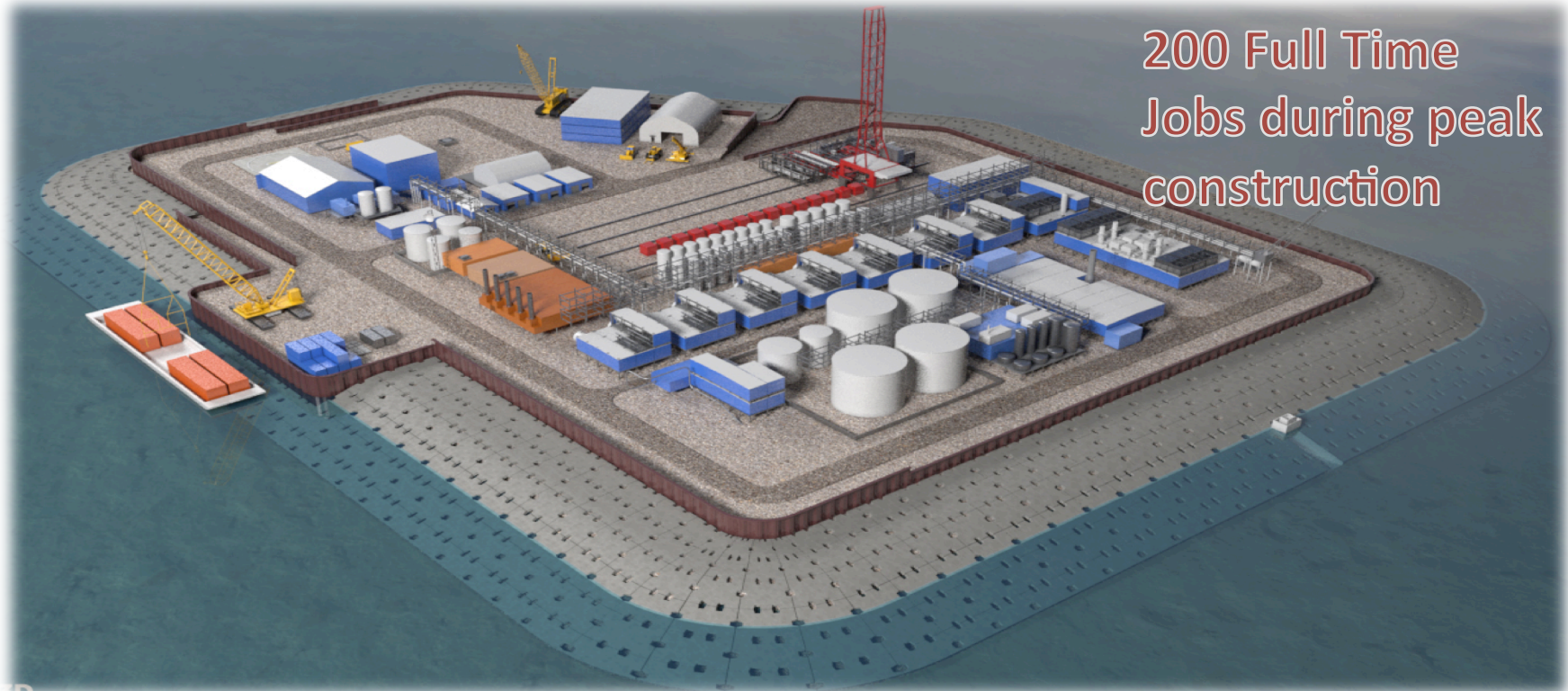
