




Armstrong Company: History

- Denver-based independent operator with satellite office in Anchorage
- Founded by Bill Armstrong in 1985
- Active in Alaska since 2001
- Originated Oooguruk and Nikaitchuq prospects
- Developed the North Fork gas field on the Kenai Peninsula in 2007
- ➤ Partnered in over 30 North Slope exploration wells



Armstrong Company: Current Joint Venture

- Started assembling acreage in 2008
- Partnered with Repsol in 2011
- ➤ 19 exploration wells
- Acquired three 3-D seismic surveys
- Currently holding approx. 715,000 gross acres
- Oil Search enters joint venture effective January 2018







- ♦ Established in Papua New Guinea in 1929
- ♦ ~1,250 employees
- **♦** World-class assets:
 - 29% interest in PNG LNG Project (ExxonMobil operator)
 - 23% interest in PRL15 Papua LNG Project (Total operator)
 - 38.5% in PRL 3 P'nyang (ExxonMobil operator)
 - 60% interest in all PNG's producing oil fields (OSH operator)
- ◆ 2016 net production: 30.2 MMBOE (~82,700 BOEPD)
- ♦ Market capitalization ~A\$11bn (~US\$8bn)
- Listed on ASX (Share Code: OSH)

Kuukpik Corporation, Village of Nuiqsut


- Surface land owner

Nanushuk Development: Oil

- ➤ Nanushuk and Alpine C reservoirs
- 3 production pads, 146 wells
- Projected oil production rate: 120,000 BOPD
- ➤ 30° 38° API gravity crude
- > 750 MMBO of recoverable reserves
- First oil projected in 2023




Pikka Nanushuk Discovery: A New Play Concept


Willow Nanushuk Discovery




New Play Type – Nanushuk Shelf-Edge Delta
